SHOW REGULATIONS

1. **JURISDICTION:** The Show will be held under the licence and rules of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. as in force in September 2010
2. **REGISTRATION etc.** All dogs entered for competition or otherwise, must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club, Unit 36 Greenmount Office Park, Dublin 6W. Entries for Greyhounds already registered with the Irish Coursing Club will be accepted without further registration.
3. **VENUE & Date:** The Show will be held at CARLOW TOWN HURLING GROUNDS on Saturday 18th September 2010. (Show grounds open at 7.30am.)

Car Park €5.00. Catalogues €5.00 on Show Day

Car Park & Catalogues may be prepaid with entries €4.00 (£3.50Stg) each

4. **ENTRIES:** Service Charge 1st. Dog €19.00 (£18.00 Stg.).

There will be a service charge of €7.00 (£6.00 Stg.) for each additional dog entered.

Stakes Classes: €7.00 (£6.00 Stg.) extra (Exhibits must be entered in breed Class.

Veteran Stakes: €7.00 (£6.00 Stg.) It is not necessary to enter Veterans in Breed classes.

Champion Stakes: €7.00 (£6.00 Stg.)

Junior Handling: €5.00 (£4.00 Stg.) Free if entered in Breed.

Obediance Open : €10.00 (£9.00) Beginners, Novice, Graduate & Limit. €6.00 (£5.00)

Fees of exhibitors arriving late or failing to arrive will be forfeited. No entries will be accepted without the appropriate Service Charge., which cannot be refunded under any circumstances. Entries will be received up to and including Friday 27th August 2010 (postmark) by the Show Secretary:

- a) **REJECTING ENTRIES etc.:** The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry, advertisement or other insertion in the catalogue or allocation of stand space at the show.
 - b) **INELIGIBLE ENTRIES:** A transfer of an incorrect entry as to sex or breed may be allowed by the Secretary prior to the commencement of judging and a dog entered in an age class for which it is not eligible may be transferred to the next appropriate age class if applicable in that breed otherwise to Open Class but in no other respects.
 - c) **ENTRY FORMS (mistakes in):** The Catalogue will be compiled from the entry forms submitted by exhibitors and while every endeavour will be made to have forms correctly interpreted, the Carlow and District Canine Club cannot accept any responsibility for mistakes which may bring exhibitors within the purview of Irish Kennel Club Rule 15, Section 1, or for clerical mistakes that may occur during compilation.
5. As there are no entry fees being charged, Prize cards will be given to 1st 2nd 3rd and reserve in each class. Rosettes will be given to Best of Breed Reserve Best of Breed and Group winners.
 6. Special prizes offered for competition by or through a specialist club shall be collected and distributed by that club.
 7. **VETERINARY EXAMINATION:** The Veterinary Surgeon on call will have the power to exclude any exhibit which in his opinion is not in a fit state for exhibition on account of Disease, lice or other cause.
 8. **EXHIBITS:** Each exhibitor shall be responsible to keep their exhibits under proper control at all times
 - b) Every exhibit must be removed by the owner or agent not later than 6.30 p.m.

9. **Judges:** In the event of any appointed Judge failing to keep his or her engagement the Committee shall have the right to appoint another Judge or Judges.
10. **JUDGING:** Judging will commence at 10.30 a.m. Sharp. No claim will be considered in the event of any exhibit being late.
- a) No person will be allowed in the Judging ring except the Judge, Show Officials, or an Exhibitor taking in a dog for adjudication.
- b) The exhibition number of each dog must be clearly displayed by the handler, who shall not wear a badge or other decoration in the judging ring.
- c) The Club will not be responsible for the exhibition of any exhibit in the ring at the time of judging.
11. **PRIZE MONEY: All prize money must be collected before the Show ends.**
12. **Interpretation:** The Committee of the Promoting Club shall be the Show Committee within the meaning of the Irish Kennel Club Ltd. rules, and all disputes (if any) shall be dealt with by the Committee. Parties to any such dispute shall have the right to appeal to the Irish Kennel Club Ltd..
13. **ALL ANNOUNCEMENTS** appearing in the Evening Herald; prior to the date of closing of entries and in reference to any alterations made by the committee in the schedule or in these regulations shall be deemed sufficient notice thereof.
14. **ACCIDENT OR DAMAGE:** The Club will not be responsible for any loss or damage sustained through accident by exhibits, exhibitors or other persons attending the show.
15. **Junior Handling:** The dog must be the bona fide property of the family of the junior handler. Nominate the junior handler on the entry form also his/her age. The age of the handler on the 1st. January is the age to be taken for the rest of the year when entering classes.

Re: Registration of Dogs Entered

Addition to above Rule:

Failure to comply with the above will result in:

(A) The Dog being disqualified from the event and

(B) The exhibitor being fined €130.00

The implementation of which shall be a Normal (I.K.C.) Office routine

PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOUR DOG IS REGISTERED CORRECTLY BEFORE THE DAY OF THE SHOW, AND WHERE POSSIBLE ENSURE TO FILL IN THE REGISTRATION ON THE ENTRY FORM.

RULES FOR GROUP JUDGING & BEST IN SHOW

- 1 The promoting body will not accept any responsibility, nor be under any obligation to see that dogs eligible to compete are exhibited in their particular Groups or for best in Show, other than announcing in the ring that judging is about to take place. The promoting body will not accept any responsibility in the case of an exhibit that is excluded from competing in a Group, or for Best in Show, owing to the judging of its breeds not having been completed, or for any other reason.
- 2 Competition in Group Classes will be confined to undefeated winners
- 3 No dog shall be entitled to compete in a group where any prize or award has been withheld from it at the show..
- 4 An entry fee will not be payable for any of the Groups or for best in Show
- 5 Groups will be divided into 10 sectors as defined in the Irish Kennel Club Rules, Undefeated winners in any Variety Not Classed section may compete in their appropriate Groups and if eligible for the award of best in show.
- 6 Upon entering the ring competitors must produce their best of breed rosettes won on the day.
- 7 In each Group the Judges shall pick Best of Group Reserve Best of Group, 3rd and 4th absentees must be marked.
- 8 Competition for Best in Show is confined to the winners of the ten groups. Competition for the award of Reserve Best in Show will be confined to the winners of groups and the reserve winner in the Group from which the winner of Best in Show was picked.
- 9 If the Group Judging has not commenced before 4.30 p.m. a Best of Breed winner may leave the Show but must notify the Show Secretary in writing that the exhibit will not be present for the Group Judging. Otherwise all exhibits qualified for the Group must be exhibited therein. An exhibit failing to report for the Group will incur a fine of €25, unless a valid reason is lodged with the Show Secretary before the Group Judging commences.
- 10 During the exhibition of dogs, the judge officiating will not allow under any circumstances any form of distraction by ringsiders and will disqualify any exhibit which is being assisted in its performance by any person other than the handler.

CLASS DEFINITIONS
(The word 'Dog' includes both sexes)

Puppy Class is confined to dogs over 6 and under 12 months of age on the day of the Show

Junior Class is confined to dogs over 9 and under 18 months of age on the day of the Show.

Intermediate Class is confined to dogs over 15 and under 24 months on the day of the Show.

Open Class is confined to dog over 15 months on the day of the Show.

Champion Class is confined to dogs that have attained the title of Champion under the Rules & Regulations of the Irish Kennel Club or other Kennel Authority recognised by the Irish Kennel Club.

Veteran Class is confined to dog over 8 years of age on the day of the Show

Field Trial Class is confined to dogs who have won at least a reserve in a Puppy, Nov-ice, Derby or Open Stake as defined in the Field Trial Rules & Regulations.

A copy of the relevant win at Field Trial must accompany the entry form.

Please Note: A Veteran Dog who is a Champion may enter in either Veteran or Champion Class but not both.

N.B.: A Dog or Bitch may be entered in ONE BREED CLASS ONLY (No double entries)

Brace Class is for two exhibits of the same or different sexes of the same breed belonging to the same person, each exhibit having been entered in some class other than brace or team.

NOTE: Dogs under the age of six months are not allowed into the show grounds. All dogs entered must be registered or transferred at the Irish Kennel Club in the name of the Exhibit

Obedience Classes:

Beginners Confined to dogs or handlers which have not won three or more first prizes in any obedience test under Irish Kennel Club Rules or under any other recognised Kennel test.

Novice is confined to dogs who have not been awarded (a) a Green Star in any obedience test (b) four or more firsts in any obedience test with the exception of Beginners.

Graduate is confined to dogs who have not been awarded (a) a Green Star in any obedience test (b) four or more firsts in any obedience test with the exception of Beginners and Novice.

Limit is confined to dogs who have not been awarded (a) a Green Star in any obedience test (b) four or more firsts in any obedience with the exception of Beginners, Novice or Graduate.

Open is open to all dogs of any breed or variety.

Veteran Stakes

It is not necessary to enter Veterans in the Breed class, you may enter in the Veteran stakes only. Entry fee for Veteran Stakes only €7.00 (£6.00 Stg.)
